





DESCRIPTION OF THE BUNGALOW

Digana Village holiday home is a two storied house with following facilities.

Ground Floor: - 02 non AC bedrooms with attached bathrooms.

- Single beds with linen. A dining area with seating capacity for 08 people. Pantry with cutlery.

First Floor : - 02 AC bedrooms with attached bathroom.


 Double beds with linen. Also a cot for an infant in Master bed room.


- A common TV area (32' LCD with a DVD player)


Hot water is available for attached bathrooms. Gas supply / hotplate, crockery & cutlery are available.

Parking is available within the Holiday Home compound only for one vehicle.

However, there is space to park at least two vehicles on the approach road safely.

MEALS


Guests are not permitted to cook meals unless for preparation of light snacks (tea/coffee, sugar and bottled water are available in the holiday home).

Main meals could be ordered from the Village restaurant to be delivered to the holiday home or for dine in at the restaurant.

Payments for meals must be settled to the restaurant before departure.











RESERVATIONS

Reservations can be done only by Visa Signature Cardholders subject to availability of the bungalow.

RESERVATION FEE

Rs. 4000/- per day for reservations during the month of April, August & December

Rs. 3000/- per day for other reservations

No refunds will be made for any cancellation of reservations.

PERIOD OF STAY

Maximum stay is limited to 04 days, 03 nights except for the Kandy Perahara season in August.

During Kandy Perahara season maximum stay is limited to 02 days, 01 night.

NUMBER OF OCCUPANTS

Maximum number of occupants should not exceed 08 persons (Including children).

WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM OCCUPANTS

All occupants should exercise utmost care in handling all equipments of the Holiday Home.

Damages to any property in the holiday Home should be born by the person who made the reservation.

Occupants are kindly requested to be mindful in using water / electricity etc. and cleanliness of the Holiday Home.

The Bank or the Holiday Home keepers should not be held responsible for any loss/damage to any personal item/s of the guests and the safety of belongings shall be at the sole responsibility of the guests.

All occupants are requested to avoid any misconduct which would cause inconvenience to other occupants/ neighbours of the Village.

SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS

All visitors are requested to produce their National Identity Card or any other accepted form of identity enabling the main gate security to cross check with the reservation details.

Visitors with no prior notice of arrival will not be allowed to enter the Holiday Home unless approval is provided by the person who reserved the Holiday Home to the main gate security either in advance or on the arrival of the guests at the gate.

Checking IN/OUT Procedure

The Holiday Home will be ready for occupations at 3.00 p.m. on arrival date and departure time should be not later than 10.00 a.m. on the departure date.

All visitors shall enter the required details and sign the Visitors Register on arrival.

Keys to the Holiday Home will be provided by the caretaker of the Holiday Home.

The occupants shall inform the caretaker at least two hours prior to departure enabling them to carry out the routine inspections on equipment of the Holiday Home.

Occupants shall signoff the Visitors Register prior to the departure and shall hand over the keys to the caretaker.
